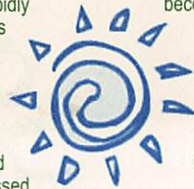


### Did you know that you don't need the sun to shine to utilize SOLAR ENERGY at night?

Solar Energy takes many shapes and forms, and is rapidly becoming one of America's major growth industries. Emerging nations are also turning to solar solutions because they do not want to build large central power grids. Passive solar architecture (like solar panels on your roof) provides free heating and cooling for millions of homes worldwide. Every time the demand for solar energy doubles, the costs go down about 20%. Last fall, there was a successful \$100 million solar bond initiative in San Francisco and the mayor of San Diego has expressed interest in implementing a similar solar bond. ### Did you know that NUCLEAR POWER is the most expensive technological failure in human history?

Nukes have swallowed more than a trillion dollars in invested capital in the US alone and their radioactive waste problems remain a technological and political nightmare. Today, America's 100-plus nuclear reactors are dangerously vulnerable to terrorist attacks, and regularly emit deadly radiation which threatens people in surrounding communities. Nuclear reactors are more dangerous, unreliable and expensive than ever. And despite the best promises of the industry's promoters, the reactors are rapidly deteriorating and becoming increasingly dangerous. In the wake of Three Mile Island and Chernobyl, there is no sane future for nuclear power except a rapid phase-out in concert with the spread of renewables and efficiency.



### Did you know that making electricity is the leading cause of industrial air pollution in the US, emitting billions of tons of carbon dioxide each year?

Meanwhile, there's enough wind potential (clean energy) in Texas, Kansas and North Dakota to supply the entire United States with clean energy for all its electrical needs. Wind power is the cheapest and fastest growing new source of energy capacity on earth - growing worldwide at more than 25% a year. Our thanks to the Green Mountain Energy Company, the nation's largest retail provider of clean energy, who will be supporting the generation of enough wind power for the 42 shows on the tour to make the tour's electricity usage effectively neutral in its impact on global warming. The company will be supporting the generation of enough new wind power to cover the electricity usage for the tour, estimated to be approximately 500-megawatt hours based on other performances at the venues. Based on this estimate of electricity usage for the tour, it will offset the production of 327 tons of carbon dioxide (CO2), which avoids as much CO2 as not driving a car 726,600 miles.

**Did you know FORESTS are the foundation of vital ecosystems and the natural balancing mechanisms to combat global warming but they are being destroyed for private profit?**

Beyond the global warming repercussions of deforestation, the physical act of clear cutting, over-logging, and conversion of forest into grazing land causes run-off that destroys our waterways and turns our forests into deserts. **Did you know that liquid hydrogen and oxygen can be converted into electricity to run a car and the only emission is water vapor?**

It's called fuel cell technology and vehicles with this technology are similar to battery-powered electric vehicles except that fuel cells replace the battery. There's a revolution going on under the hood of the automobile, which currently accounts for much of the world's air pollution and fossil fuel addiction. Hybrid cars, which combine an electric and a gasoline motor for enhanced fuel economy and reduced emissions, are now showing that commercially attractive automobiles can get 50 miles per gallon and more. By all accounts,



the days of the traditional gas-powered internal combustion engine are numbered---and for the health of our planet, lets hope that number is small. Over two years ago, Honda released Insight, the first gasoline-electric hybrid to prove itself in the US, and just this year released a Civic Hybrid too. Honda's hybrid cars charge their electric motor in part by stepping on the brake.. no need to plug them in! Check out BOTH of these HYBRID CARS at the Green Highway village at the concert tonight.

**Did you know restaurant grease can be recycled and used to power up a generator?**

BIOMASS is a new way to describe our oldest fuel. Biomass uses crops for energy. One example, biodiesel, is a clean burning alternative fuel that can be made from any fat or vegetable oil (usually soy) and be used in diesel engines with few or no modifications. Even leftover cooking oil is being used to power machines. Using a farm-grown fuel that decreases emissions and dependence on foreign oil is catching on. Biodiesel is beginning to enjoy commercial success as one of the fastest growing alternative fuels available.

All that needs to happen to fully tap into this endless resource is to stop wasting our money on fossil fuels and nuclear power. "GREEN HIGHWAY Trucking Company, Griffin Industries, Industries and World Energy for making vehicles on the tour to run on B20 - a
